Papers from Engineering, Pure Sciences, Management, Bio-engineering, Food Technology, Architecture and Education were read by the participants during the contest. Three hand on workshops on review, academic writing and writing citations were conducted for the participants and based on the feedback on the workshops this year again we are continuing with the same workshop and coming up with something new. Theme of the last year contest was “Achieving Sustainable Development Goals’. We have kept the theme same keeping in mind that good research can help in achieving sustainable development goals by 2030. Winners received cash prize along with certificate and all participants got participation certificate. Participants also learnt from other presentation and experiences shared by experts during inaugural, judging and valedictory sessions.

Open for all interested in upgrading themselves

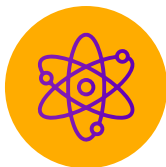

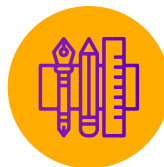

- > The competition is open for students of PG / M. Phil / Ph. D. from any University.
- > All submissions will be considered for presentation and award.
- > Each contestant is to read the paper online and time allotted for the same will be 10 minutes which includes 3 minutes of questioning.
- > Abstract of each paper written in 12 point Times New Roman font within 250 words with title, name of author, author's department and institute and full postal address of the author with mobile email address and Key words is to be uploaded during the registration.
- > Copy of his/her identity card of the respective institute is also to be attached.
- > Certificate for participation will be given to all presenters.
- > Best Paper Awards will also be given to the top presenters.
- > Selection of the best paper will be based on integration of knowledge, focus, cohesiveness, presentation skills, discussion and relevance of the topic to the theme.
- > Decision of the Judges from well-known industries and academic institutions will be Final and binding on the participants.
- > Each participant have to register separately even if they are presenting single paper.
- > Detailed schedule will be sent through mail after registration.

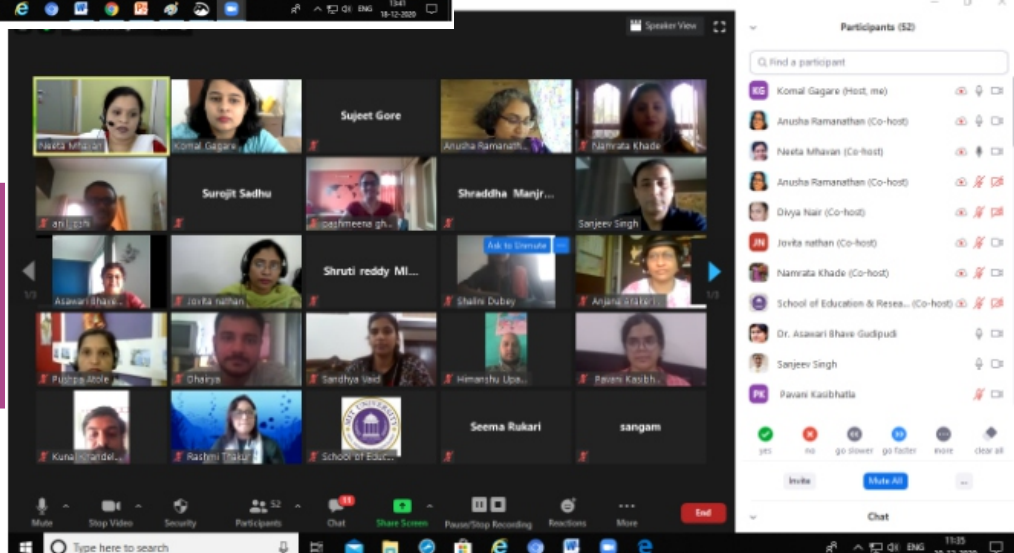

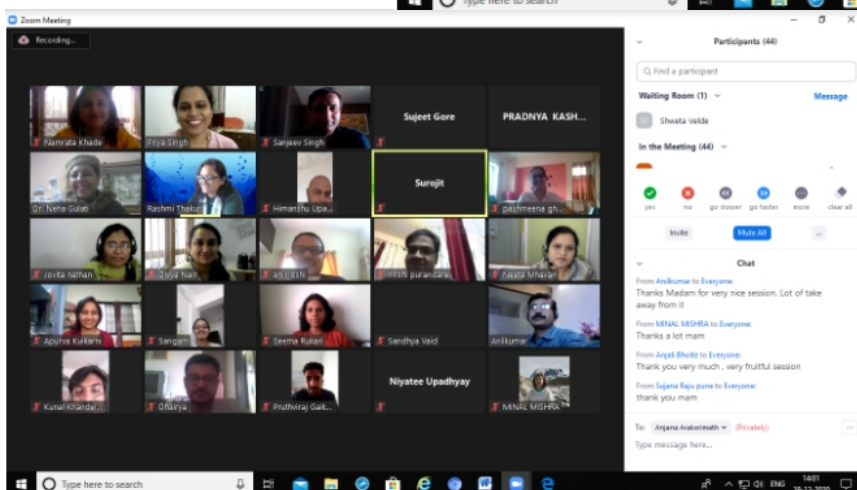
Workshop on 'Meaningful Reading-Key to quality research review'
