## About MIT-ADT University

MIT Art, Design and Technology (MIT-ADT) University was established in 2016 by the Government of Maharashtra vide the MIT Art, Design and Technology University Act, 2015 (Mah. Act. No. XXXIX of 2015), and has been in operation since the academic year 2016–17. The establishment of the university was published in the Maharashtra Gazette on 21st August 2015. It is recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, vide letter No. F-8-33/2015 (CPP-1/PU) dated 10th November 2016, and is empowered to award degrees under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.

The university was founded by Rev. Prof. Dr. Vishwanath D. Karad, who envisioned a world-class institution blending innovation, creativity, peace, and holistic education. The campus is spread across 85 acres of lush greenery on the banks of the Mula-Mutha River at Vishwaraj Baug, Loni Kalbhor, Pune, a land that once belonged to the late legendary actor Shri Raj Kapoor, acquired by MIT Group in 2001.

MIT-ADT comprises 17 constituent schools offering undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programmes in Engineering, Fine Arts, Design, Management, Marine Engineering, Biosciences, Food Technology, Film and Theatre, Drama, Music, Journalism, Humanities, Education, and more. With more than 12,000 students enrolled (including over 2,800 new admissions each year), the university emphasizes interdisciplinary learning through its creative and technology clusters, industry-focused curriculum, hands-on training, and a unique "Campus to Corporate" transformation model that includes over 20 credits dedicated to personality and skill development.

For its excellence in higher education, MIT-ADT University has been honoured with several accolades, including the "Best Campus Award" by ASSOCHAM in 2017 and the "Best Private State University in India Award" in 2018.
